How could training sessions be further improved?

Hiring a coach but this would be expensive.

Pro coaching

Targeted extra sessions for first team/second team fringe players, allowing players to train in groups of similar standards that players play against on match days.

Make more interesting with planning and including everyone

Qualified coach

More game-based practice using grass wickets. The nets are too bouncy to replicate batting on a pitch.

I think a paid coach who runs structured session would be hugely beneficial to not just the 1st team but also the new players we have seen this year particularly.

Have dedicated days for youth to play on days when senior training is not on. (If at all possible)

Fielding equipment, training tracks. Potential coach

Unsure

An outside coach

Cater for the whole club. Intermediate and beginners can often feel intimidated by the 1st XI

More coaching

Better mobile nets to roll easily on and off cricket strip

A proper paid coach so doesn't fall on the captain and more people would be willing to come

Make more interesting with planning and including everyone

More fielding drills such as sliding stops, catching, and throwing drills.

Introduction of a new coach for the woman has been a great improvement already. Brings some new drills and perspectives to the club.

If we could have more sessions per week

more...?

It would be great to be able to offer training sessions for girls only, but not enough coaches are available.

Have a strip dedicated to training, keep Marlene ladies coach

Club need the second team to bridge the gap to the first team, maybe an improvement in facilities like getting an electric scoreboard and a better-quality roll-on net for grass net sessions and practice

Expand the square to allow more grass-based practice for youth and seniors.

I think as mentioned above the emphasis should be on getting a coach. Even someone like Fin Dixon, paid £20 a session, would be around £300 a season so affordable. Also takes pressure of Ryan.

If the club house is sorted, I think that will make massive strides in making Cam a more attractive place for people to come and play for us.

Just keep making sure we have a good strong youth

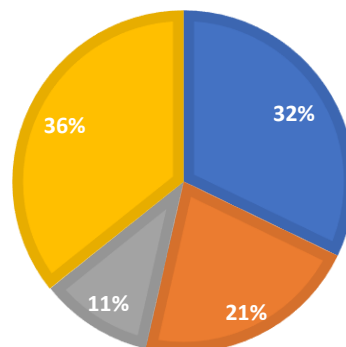
